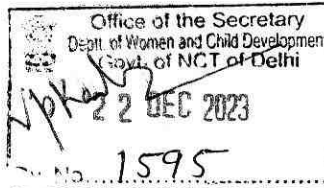

Subject: Admissibility of pensionary benefits to the redeployed staff under the Government of NCT of Delhi.

Sir / Madam,

The Services Department redeployes the Surplus Staff under CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990. The terms and conditions of such redeployment are laid down in the Orders redeploying the Surplus Staff / CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990. However, the Principal Accounts Office, Government of NCT of Delhi, is having doubts with regard to the admissibility of pensionary benefits to the Surplus Staff redeployed under CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990, redeployed on or after 01.01.2004.

On receipt of the same, the Services Department referred the matter to the Finance Deptt. and the Deptt. has opined as under in the matter:-

"...as per Government of India, Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare, O.M. No. 28/39/2004-P&PW (B), dated 28.7.2005, all the employees who have entered into Government service on or after 01.01.2004 and prior to this were in service under an autonomous body set up by the Central Government and were governed by the Old Pension Scheme under CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, they will continue to be governed by the Old Pension Scheme. They have further clarified that those who were governed under the CPF Scheme under the Central or State Government prior to joining the service under the Government on or after 01.01.2004 would not be allowed to join the Old Pension Scheme under the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972."

It has also been clarified that the employees of DEDA were not governed under the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972. Therefore, the Surplus employees of DEDA who were redeployed under the CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990, by the Services Department with the effective date of their redeployment as on or after 01.01.2004, are not entitled for the benefits of Old Pension Scheme. However, the clarification given by the Services Department vide letters dated 12.07.2005 and dated 16.01.2006 would be applicable only in those cases where the Surplus Staff has been redeployed under CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990, by the Services Department with the effective date of their redeployment prior to 01.01.2004.

Therefore, in view of the above advice of Finance Department, you are requested to act accordingly while extending the benefit of Old Pension Scheme to the Surplus Staff redeployed under CCS (Redeployment of Surplus Staff) Rules, 1990, by the Services Department.
