Objective (s) of the scheme

To bring about transition to enable empowerment of targeted groups, wherein support cannot be provided in its regular scheme. To adopt rehabilitative measures in terms of professional programme to bring self-reliance among targeted group. To make the grantee institutions self-sufficient in their finance.

Scheme details :-

The Voluntary Action Cell (VAC) provides Grant-in-Aid to voluntary organizations in Delhi under the Delhi Grant Rules, 2008. The scheme supports innovative welfare projects, particularly for women and children, promotes rehabilitation and self-reliance among vulnerable groups, and assists institutions in becoming financially sustainable while maintaining a repository of associated organizations.

In addition, the Cell also facilitates collaboration with CSOs/NGOs on a pro bono basis for strengthening and supporting departmental schemes through community outreach, capacity building, awareness generation, technical support, and convergence-based interventions

The Organization should be registered under the societies Registration Act, 1860 and have existed for a period of three years, should have facilities, resources, personnel and experience for undertaking welfare programme for women and children/Trust under ACT, 1882. The Department of Women and Child Development GNCTD releases advertisement every year for inviting applications/proposals from the organization for the Grant in Aid as per terms and conditions of Grant—in-Aid scheme. In response to advertisement, the interested NGO have to submit two set of the proposals offline in the VAC Branch.
