

Mission Shakti

Mission Shakti is a flagship initiative of the Government of India aimed at ensuring **the safety, security, and empowerment of women** across all stages of life. Implemented by the Department of Women and Child Development in Government of NCT of Delhi, the mission integrates various schemes and programmes to provide a comprehensive support system for women and girls. Launched with the vision of creating a safe and enabling environment for women, Mission Shakti has **two key components- 'Sambal' and 'Samarthya'**.

The "**Sambal**" sub-scheme is for **safety and security of women**. The components of 'sambal' sub scheme consist of erstwhile schemes of **One Stop Centre (OSC), Women Helpline (WHL), Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP)** and **Nari Adalats**. Whereas, the "**Samarthya**" sub-scheme is for **empowerment of women**. The components of 'Samarthya' sub scheme consists of erstwhile schemes of **Ujjwala Homes, Swadhar Greh and Working Women Hostel, National Creche Scheme for children of working mothers and Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)**. It also consists **Hubs** at national, state and district levels for Empowerment of Women.

Details about sub-schemes are provided in subsequent sections :-

One Stop centre (OSC)

- **Type of Scheme:** Central share: 100%
- **The objective of the scheme:** The objective of Sakhi-One Stop Centre in each district is to provide following five essential facilities to the aggrieved women/women affected by violence under one roof:-
 1. Psycho-social counselling,
 2. Legal assistance,
 3. Police facilitation,
 4. Medical care and
 5. Temporary shelter under one roof
- **Target Beneficiary:**
 Women affected by violence and in distress, both in private and public spaces under one roof and facilitate immediate, emergency and non-emergency access to a range of services including medical, legal, temporary shelter, police assistance, psychological and counselling support to fight against any forms of violence against women.

Women Helpline

- **Type of Scheme:** Central Share : 100%
- **The objective of OSC scheme aims to:** The Women Helpline provides toll-free 24-hours telecom service to women seeking support and information by connecting them with Emergency Response Support System (ERSS) for all emergency services like police/ fire/ Ambulance services and with One Stop Centres. The WHL will also provide information about government scheme/ programmes, facilities and will also connect women with the statutory officers under various legislations like Dowry Prohibition Officers, Child Marriage Prevention Officers, and Protection Officers etc. as per requirement within the local area in which she resides or is employed.

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao

- **Type of Scheme:** Central share: 100%
- **The objective of the scheme:**
 - (i) Improvement in the Sex Ratio at Birth (SRB) by 2 points every year.
 - (ii) Improvement in the percentage of institutional deliveries or sustained at the rate of 95% or above.
 - (iii) 1% increase in 1st Trimester ANC Registration per year.
 - (iv) 1% increase in enrolment at secondary education level and skilling of girls/women per year.
 - (v) To check dropout rate among girls at secondary and higher secondary levels,
 - (vi) Raising awareness about safe menstrual hygiene management (MHM).
- **Target Beneficiary:**
 - Primary:** Young and newly married couples and expecting parents, Adolescents (girls and boys) and youth, Households and communities
 - Secondary:** Schools and AWCs, Medical doctors/ practitioners, private hospitals, nursing homes, diagnostic centers etc., Officials, PRIs/ULBs, frontline workers, Women Collectives and SHGs, civil society organizations, media, industry, religious leaders etc.

Shakti Sadan

- **Type of Scheme:** Centre share :: State share : 60:40
- **The objective of OSC scheme aims to:** Shakti Sadan is aimed at creating a safe and enabling environment for the women in distress including trafficked women and thereby give them the strength to overcome their difficult circumstances and make a fresh start. The following services are provided in the Shakti Sadan:
 - -Food
 - -Clothing (Once in a year)
 - -Medical Aid- (Need base)
 - -Sanitary Napkin (on need base)
 - -Pocket Money-(as per guidelines)
 - -Recreational activities-(as per guidelines)
 - -Vocational training under NCVT approved plan-(Need Basis)
 - -Legal Aid (Need Basis)
 - -Psycho-social Counselling-(Need Basis)
 - -Toiletries-(Need Basis)
 - -PM Jan Dhan Yojana Bank
 - -Account (To be arranged through local bank)
 - -Ayushman Bharat Health Card
 - -Education (to be arranged through health Department).
 - -Jan Dhan @ Rs. 500/- per month to one resident/beneficiary.
- **Target Beneficiary:**

Sakhi Niwas (Working Women Hostel)

- **Type of Scheme:** Centre share:: State share: 60:40
- **The objective of the scheme:** To promote availability of safe and conveniently located accommodation for working women and other women pursuing higher education or training, who need to live away from their families due to professional commitments. The scheme also aligns well with Sustainable Development Goal 5 (SDG-5) that mandates adopting and strengthening sound programs for the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls at all levels. The scheme also addresses women's right to work and to free choice of profession and employment as mandated under the Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW).
- **Target Beneficiary:** Working women and other women pursuing higher education or training, who need to live away from their families due to professional commitments.

Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) 2.0

- **Type of Scheme:** Centre share:: State share: 60:40
- **The objective of the scheme:** The objectives of the PMMVY is to provide cash incentive for partial compensation for the wage loss so that the woman can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first child; and to improve health seeking behaviour amongst the Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM). The scheme also seeks to promote positive behavioural change towards girl child by providing additional cash incentive for the second child, if that is a girl child.
- **Target Beneficiary:** All Pregnant Women (PW) and Lactating Mothers (LM) for the first two living children provided the second child is a girl, excluding those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force shall not be entitled to benefits under PMMVY. Pregnant and Lactating AWWs/AWHs/ASHA may also avail the benefits under the PMMVY subject to fulfillment of scheme conditionality.
- **Eligibility Criteria:** The criteria for determining socially and economically disadvantaged sections of society will be the following/documents required:
 - i. Women belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes;
 - ii. Women who are partially (40%) or fully disabled (Divyang Jan)
 - iii. Women holder of BPL rations Card
 - iv. Women Beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (PMJAY) under Ayushman Bharat
 - v. Women holding E-shram card
 - vi. Women farmers who are beneficiaries under Kishan Samman Nidhi
 - vii. Women holding MGNREGA Job Card
 - viii. Women whose net family income is less than Rs. 8 Lakh per annum
 - ix. Pregnant and Lactating AWWs/ AWHs/ ASHAs
 - x. Any other category as may be prescribed by the Central Government

Benefits under Scheme:

S.No.	Order of Birth	Conditions
1	First child	On registration of pregnancy - 1st installment of Rs. 3000/- is given.
		On registration of birth and completion of first Cycle of immunization - 2nd installment of Rs. 2000/- is given.
2	Second child	Provided second child is a girl child - one Installment of Rs. 6000/- is given.

In case of miscarriage/still birth, the beneficiary would be treated as fresh beneficiary in event of any future pregnancy. The funds to the beneficiaries under PMMVY will be transferred directly to their Bank/Post Office account in Direct Benefit Transfer Mode. An eligible beneficiary can apply, at any point of time but not later than 730 days of pregnancy. LMP registered in the MCP card will be the date of pregnancy to be considered in this respect. If a beneficiary delivers twins/ triplet/ quadruplet in her second pregnancy, with one or more

children being girl, then she will be receiving incentive for second girl child as per the PMMVY 2.0 norms.

Note: Under PMMVY, the Angawadi Worker would be provided incentives for facilitating beneficiaries' enrollment as per installment wise norms decided by MoWCD, GoI. The provision for the same is being done on the new portal by NIC team, GoI and shall accordingly be communicated to State for disbursement.

Hub for Empowerment of Women

- **Type of Scheme:** Centre share:: State share: 60:40
- **The objective of OSC scheme aims to:** Hub for Empowerment of Women aims to facilitate inter-sectoral convergence of schemes and programs meant for women both at the central (NHEW), State/ UT level (SHEW) and district level (DHEW) with the mandate to create an environment in which women realize their full potential. The support under the HEW would be for guiding, linking and hand-holding women to various institutional and schematic set ups for their empowerment and development including equal access to healthcare, quality education, career and vocational counseling/ training, financial inclusion, entrepreneurship, backward and forward linkages, health and safety for workers, social security and digital literacy at districts/ Blocks/ Gram Panchayats level across the country.
- **Other details, if any:** In Delhi there is 1 State Hub for Empowerment of Women and District Hub for Empowerment of Women in each District which are functional under the Dept of WCD, GNCTD.
